

Travel to Andøya

By air:

The most convenient way of getting to Andøya is by air. The Andøya Airport has been in operation since 1964 and is currently operated by the Norwegian company Widerøe. These routes are currently available:

Andenes – Tromsø: 08:38 and 16:51

Andenes – Bodø: 05:39, 13:34 and 19:05

Tromsø – Andenes: 18:22

Bodø – Andenes: 12:05, 15:20 and 20:55



From *Oslo* you may reach both *Tromsø* and *Bodø* via direct flights several times per day. By ordering your tickets via SAS or Widerøe you ensure that all necessary connections are taken care of. The tickets may be ordered online from here:

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By sea:

You may also get to Andøya by sea. The Norwegian Coastal Voyage (Hurtigruten) will take you from Bergen in the south of Norway to the south end of Andøya. This journey will last for 3-4 days and will show you some of the most scenic coastal regions in the world.

By train & bus (most of the travel by train):

If you start in *Oslo* you may go by train to *Fauske* which is just a few kilometers from *Bodø*, and then continue to *Andenes* by the connecting bus. The train takes 17 hours from *Oslo* to *Fauske* and the journey by bus to *Andenes* takes about 8 hours. You may also take the train all the way to *Bodø* and from there go to *Andenes* by plane as shown earlier.
